Stratford District Cllr

Cllr Adam advised the food waste in the small green bins goes to a Severn Trent Anaerobic Digester Plant in Coleshill. Warwickshire County Council has a contract with them for 18 months. (SDC and WDC use this contract). Stratford District Council is monitoring the use of the food green bin scheme to see how much is being collected and whether the scheme is cost effective. Cllr Adam attended a meeting with the HS2 Construction Minister, he raised when roads are closed, it very often means there is no Bus Service, this isolates villagers who have no alternative means of

Cllr Adam asked for any problems recognised by the residents of Ufton - Lynch HGV lorry drivers drive very fast, do not slow down when going through the village and tailgate each other closely. The crews who put the signs out late are night are very often loud, shouting to each other an playing music in their vehicles, could they be more considerate.

There are still cones and signs along Bascote Road, no work has been undertaken for weeks. Planning - the solar farm additional consultation have been received and SDC do not intend to open it again. It will take a while for the information to be processed, concerns about the landscape are an issue. The solar farm is just under 50 MW (49.99), it is just within the size Local Authorities van consider. If it was over 50MW the application would have to go via the Government.
