HS2 Road Works Updated notice of upcoming works, A425, Southam

Works are needed to allow the A425 temporary diversion road to be connected to the existing highway. Works will be carried out between 16 January 2023 and 17 February 2023. To carry out these works safely, single lane closures with temporary traffic lights will be required. We previously informed you about these works however to complete these works we will now also be implementing an overnight closure on 6 February between the hours of 10pm and **6am**. A fully signed diversion will be in place. Two-way temporary traffic lights will be in place at two points on the A425 from 16 January 2023 to 17 February 2023. Access to all properties will be maintained. Our workforce maybe on site one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment.

A425 Daventry Road from 9th January 2022:

Temporary closure of A425 Daventry Road, Southam/Shuckburgh Road, Napton on the hill and Napton Road, Lower Shuckburgh closed to vehicular traffic between Welsh Road East, Southam and Sawbridge Road, Lower Shuckburgh.

Cheaper Bus Travel

Warwickshire residents are encouraged to choose cheaper bus travel this year as a new scheme to save money on fares launches.

Most Warwickshire bus operators have signed up to a scheme aimed at capping the price of a Single ticket. This will help families, commuters and other passengers save money on travel over the winter. The scheme, backed by £60 million of government investment, caps single tickets at £2 until 31 March 2023 across England.

In Warwickshire, the following operators have signed-up to the scheme:

- National Express West Midlands
- Pulhams
- A&M Group Flexibus (Service 9 only)

 IndieGo PLUS Demand Responsive Transport (DRT)

Designed to help with the rising cost of living, it is hoped that Warwickshire residents will seriously consider leaving the car behind and use the bus instead. With a major network of routes spanning the county, there is sure to be one that will make it a real viable alternative to car travel. Most Bus operators now offer free Wi-Fi and USB charging points on-board, as well as apps that you can download and track your bus with.
