Warwickshire County Council is reminding residents that recycling will become even easier with extended summer opening times in operation from 3 April 2023.

Visitors are advised to pre-sort waste when packing their car for an efficient visit. Full details of all the waste streams that can be recycled at the nine recycling centres in the county, and details of how to book, can be found at [www.warwickshire.gov.uk/hwrc](http://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/hwrc).

Booking is required for a 15-minute slot for a car and there are also 30-minute slots for a car and small trailer. Where there is

availability, appointments can be made on the day, up to just a few minutes before the appointment. Advance booking is strongly recommended to avoid disappointment as the centres are likely to become extremely busy over the spring and summer months.
